Additional responsibilities may include maintaining materials, equipment, and spaces relative to the Earth Sciences program; participating in and leading professional development opportunities; contributing to organization-wide initiatives and teams; and other duties as assigned.

The successful candidate will be an innovative and inspiring educator with expertise in one or more of the following scientific areas: geology, meteorology, or alternative energies. In addition to at least a bachelor's degree in a related field, the successful candidate will possess solid classroom, group instruction, and/or outreach experience, along with the ability to differentiate instruction to meet students' needs. Teaching certification is not required. The successful candidate must possess a valid driver's license, have access to reliable transportation, and successfully complete a background check.
